DOGS:

Orienteering Tasmania has a policy of not allowing dogs at any orienteering event (except guide dogs in public places).

Dogs may disrupt wildlife and stock in public forests and on private land. We use private and public land due to the generosity of landowners and authorities responsible for that land. The “no dogs” policy respects those individuals and authorities and minimises chances of incidents arising which could jeopardise land access.
