JUNIOR SCHOLARSHIPS

INTRODUCTION:

Scholarships may be offered to suitable juniors. The form of the scholarship will usually be a one year membership of Orienteering Tasmania, which also includes membership of a club.

The intent of the scheme is to ensure that any promising junior who has demonstrated a high level of commitment by attending school orienteering and some statewide events, gains one year's free membership. The benefit of this is that they then receive O Know and the Australian Orienteer and are likely to continue as members.

GUIDELINES:

- Former guidelines have been relaxed. A club may now offer any suitable junior a club scholarship. The club is responsible for funding the scholarship.

POINTS TO NOTE:

- Once a scholarship offer has been made a club is requested to advise OT and other clubs in order to avoid duplication.
- A membership application should be completed and submitted in the normal manner.
- Clubs are expected to support and assist the scholarship holder during their first year.
