Orienteering Australia's **Member Protection Policy** is [here](#). Use the bookmarks provided to find your way through it. Although it is a lengthy document, it should be regarded as the reference for all matters relating to member protection, harassment, racial vilification, abuse, discrimination and other misconduct. It contains procedures for resolving complaints, and states Codes of Conduct for people participating in any role in the sport of orienteering in Australia. It applies to all administrators, employees, officials, coaches, competitors, and, where appropriate, non-members such as parents undertaking activities associated with orienteering.

The purpose of the Policy is to provide guidelines for the protection of the health, safety and well being of all Orienteering Australia members and those who participate in the activities of Orienteering Australia, Member Associations and Affiliated Clubs. Some of the matters covered have serious legal and financial implications.

Orienteering Tasmania has policies and practices which are consistent with OA's policy.
